Dan Mr Markey,

To ask the Minister of Justice how many times security clearance has been denied to PSNI applicants on the grounds that they had a sibling who was a member of (i) Sinn Fein; (ii) SDLP; (iii) DUP; (iv) UUP; and (v) PUP. ≺(≤3)(□

The above mentioned question was placed before the Minister of Justice, who has deemed that this is an operational matter for the Police Service of Northern Ireland. Therefore the Chief Constable has been asked to respond directly.

To date no police applicant has been turned down for having a relative in any of the following political parties: (i) Sinn Fein; (ii) SDLP; (iii) DUP; (iv) UUP; and (v) PUP.
