Dear Mr Easton,

To ask the Minister for Justice if he has any plans to re-open Holywood Police Station on a 24-hour basis. 6291/10

The above mentioned question was placed before the Minister for Justice, who has deemed that this is an operational matter for the Police Service of Northern Ireland. Therefore the Chief Constable has been asked to respond directly.

There are no plans to review the current position as it relates to Holywood Police Station. The District Commander is content that the current arrangements afford the provision of the best possible policing service to all parts of the community within the Holywood area, and indeed 'C' District as a whole.

However as is the case with such matters this will be kept under review.
