Dear Mr Robinson,

To ask the Minister of Justice how many people were (i) apprehended; (ii) processed; and (iii) charged with having possession of, or consuming, alcohol in a public place on, or during, (a) the week covering Christmas Day; (b) New Year's Eve and New Year's Day; (c) St Patrick's Day; (d) the Twelfth of July parades; (e) Gay Pride; (f) May Day; and (g) the Lord Mayor's show, in each of the last three years.

The above mentioned question was placed before the Minister of Justice, who has deemed that this is an operational matter for the Police Service of Northern Ireland. Therefore the Chief Constable has been asked to respond directly.
