To ask the Minister of Justice how many times the PSNI has recovered, from bonfires, posters which have been stolen and are the property of a political party, in each of the last five years.

The above mentioned question was placed before the Minister of Justice, who has deemed that this is an operational matter for the Police Service of Northern Ireland. Therefore the Chief Constable has been asked to respond directly.

The PSNI are unable to answer the question asked as we do not collate statistics in relation to the information requested.
