Dear Mr McQuillan MLA,

To ask the Minister of Justice how many officers have been assigned front-line duties since the appointment of the current Chief Constable; and what percentage of these have been reserve constables. 4077/10

The above mentioned question was placed before the Minister of Justice, who has deemed that this is an operational matter for the Police Service of Northern Ireland. Therefore the Chief Constable has been asked to respond directly.

Since the appointment of the current Chief Constable, 411 additional officers have been allocated to Neighbourhood and Response policing, which is the measure set in the 2010/2011 Policing Plan. All remaining Full Time Reserve Officers were already engaged in frontline operational duties.
