Dear Mr Kinahan,

To ask the Minister for Justice to list the locations where PSNI applicants can undertake the entry examinations. 6509/10

The above mentioned question was placed before the Minister for Justice, who has deemed that this is an operational matter for the Police Service of Northern Ireland. Therefore the Chief Constable has been asked to respond directly.

The locations for the police recruitment 'Initial Selection Tests' vary from campaign to campaign, but the vast majority are held in regional towns covering the geographic area of Northern Ireland, with additional venues in major cities in the Republic of Ireland, England and Scotland to reflect application trends.
