Dear Mr Burns,

To ask the Minister for Justice how many serving police officers are currently (i) on restricted duties; or (ii) suspended from duty as a result of a charge being brought against them. 6207/10

The above mentioned question was placed before the Minister for Justice, who has deemed that this is an operational matter for the Police Service of Northern Ireland. Therefore the Chief Constable has been asked to respond directly.

- (i) As of 20 April 2010, there are a total of 19 Police Officers who have been Repositioned due to related misconduct matters.
- (ii) In addition as of the same date, there are a total of 24 Police Officers who are suspended due to related misconduct matters.
