Dear Lord Morrow,

To ask the Minister of Justice how many convicted sex offenders are currently living in each council area.

The above mentioned question was placed before the Minister of Justice, who has deemed that this is an operational matter for the Police Service of Northern Ireland. Therefore the Chief Constable has been asked to respond directly.

PSNI are unable to answer the question as asked due to the fact that not all convicted sex offenders are required to notify police if they change address. We can give figures for police districts of those persons who are subject to the notification requirements of Part 2 of the Sexual Offences Act 2003, however please be advised that PSNI computer systems are not set up to capture this data by council districts and therefore the table below is compiled by District Command Areas.
