*Dear Mr McKerr,*

**To ask the Minister of Justice how many recommendations made by Criminal Justice Inspection Northern Ireland, relating to the PSNI, are currently still to be implemented; and what action he is planning to address these.**

The above mentioned question was placed before the Minister of Justice, who has deemed that this is an operational matter for the Police Service of Northern Ireland. Therefore the Chief Constable has been asked to respond directly.

The implementation and discharge of these recommendations is monitored internally by the Police Service of Northern Ireland's Organisational Improvement Committee. This is chaired by the Deputy Chief Constable. All recommendations are recorded on a software database known as Overview. Overview is the sole corporate mechanism used to monitor the implementation and discharge of all external and internal improvement recommendations.

All 39 outstanding recommendations are being monitored on Overview. Of these recommendations 20 are from reports issued to the Service in the past year and work is ongoing towards implementation. Work is also continuing in relation to the remaining 19 recommendations and all are expected to be complete by the end of this financial year. Please note however that full implementation of some of these recommendations is reliant on work with other agencies and as such the recommendations cannot be discharged until this work is complete.
